

# Biblical Timeline

1 God (Elohim) standeth in the congregation of the mighty (divine counsel); he judgeth among the gods (Elohim). 2 How long will ye judge unjustly, and accept the persons of the wicked? Selah. 6 I have said, Ye are gods (Elohim); and all of you are children of the most High (Elyon). 7 But ye shall die like men, and fall like one of the princes. 8 Arise, O God, judge the earth: for thou shalt inherit all nations. **Psalm 82**

# God's Regal Plan for Man

<sup>26</sup> And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness:

<sup>5</sup> For unto the angels hath he not put in subjection the world to come, whereof we speak. <sup>6</sup> But one in a certain place testified, saying, What is man, that thou art mindful of him? or the son of man, that thou visitest him? <sup>7</sup> Thou madest him a little lower than the angels; thou crownedst him with glory and honour, and didst set him over the works of thy hands: <sup>8</sup> Thou hast put all things in subjection under his feet. For in that he put all in subjection under him, he left nothing *that is* not put under him. But now we see not yet all things put under him. Hebrews 2:5–8

# God's Regal Plan for Man

## TEMPTATION IN THE GARDEN

- Gen 3:1-6. Satan – not yet deposed – tempted Eve in order to remain in control of his domain – his kingdom
- God allowed this because He desired for man to choose obedience – man had to qualify for his position as ruler in order to overthrow the incumbent ruler Satan.



# God's Regal Plan for Man

## WAR DECLARED!

- Gen 3:15 God's plan for man would not be thwarted. A man would qualify for the position and defeat Satan.
- Biblical History and Prophecy **focus upon this subject** – the restoration of the kingdom of God.

# God's Regal Plan for Man

<sup>5</sup> Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus: <sup>6</sup> Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God: <sup>7</sup> But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men: <sup>8</sup> And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross. <sup>9</sup> Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name: <sup>10</sup> That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of *things* in heaven, and *things* in earth, and *things* under the earth; <sup>11</sup> And *that* every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ *is* Lord, to the glory of God the Father. Philippians 2:5–11

## Hebrews 1

1 GOD, who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets, 2 Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds; 3 Who being the brightness of his glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power, when he had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high; 4 Being made so much better than the angels, as he hath by inheritance obtained a more excellent name than they. 5 For unto which of the angels said he at any time, Thou art my Son, this day have I begotten thee? And again, I will be to him a Father, and he shall be to me a Son? 6 And again, when he bringeth in the firstbegotten into the world, he saith, And let all the angels of God worship him. 7 And of the angels he saith, Who maketh his angels spirits, and his ministers a flame of fire. 8 But unto the Son he saith, Thy throne, O God, is for ever and ever: a sceptre of righteousness is the sceptre of thy kingdom. 9 Thou hast loved righteousness, and hated iniquity; therefore God, even thy God, hath anointed thee with the oil of gladness above thy fellows. 10 And, Thou, Lord, in the beginning hast laid the foundation of the earth; and the heavens are the works of thine hands: 11 They shall perish; but thou remainest; and they all shall wax old as doth a garment; 12 And as a vesture shalt thou fold them up, and they shall be changed: but thou art the same, and thy years shall not fail. 13 But to which of the angels said he at any time, Sit on my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool? 14 Are they not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?
