Welcome to this Study entitled THE FULL SCOPE OF OUR SALVATION ó Understanding WHY We are Being Saved.

For study purposes, this book is broken up into four lessons, with each lesson having an audio recording identically matching the written part. You can see that the CD TRACK breakdowns are noted in the written Lessons for a purpose to give you daily study breaks.

The following is a suggestion on how you might use this study in order to derive maximum benefit.

Week ONE:

First read through the complete Lesson One in one sitting. Then either on your way into to work, or while you are in the kitchen fixing breakfast, or at some point in your day, take the time to listen to the first track on the CD that coordinates with Lesson One. (There are FIVE tracks on each Lesson's CD, which break the lesson up into roughly 8-10 minutes each.) On the second day, reread the section following the notation of the 2nd TRACK break, and listen to Track 2 in the course of your day. The next day, reread the section following the notation of the 3rd TRACK break, and listen to Track 3 that day—continuing until you have reread each section and listened to all five tracks. In this way, you will have *read through* the Lesson two times and will have *heard* it once. Repetition is such a good teacher!

Weeks TWO—FOUR:

Continue the format laid out above for the remaining Lessons. In this way you will have completed the entire study in a one-month timeframe.

It is my prayer that this study helps you to understand more completely the wonderful future that awaits us as a Child of God. As Paul prayed for the Church in Ephesus, so I pray this for you:

Ephesians 1

13 In Him, you also, after listening to the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation-- having also believed, you were sealed in Him with the Holy Spirit of promise, 14 who is given

as a pledge of our inheritance, with a view to the redemption of God's own possession, to the praise of His glory. 15 For this reason I too, having heard of the faith in the Lord Jesus which exists among you, and your love for all the saints, 16 do not cease giving thanks for you, while making mention of you in my prayers; 17 that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you a spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the knowledge of Him. 18 I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened, so that you may know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints, 19 and what is the surpassing greatness of His power toward us who believe. These are in accordance with the working of the strength of His might 20 which He brought about in Christ, when He raised Him from the dead, and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places, 21 far above all rule and authority and power and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age, but also in the one to come. 22 And He put all things in subjection under His feet, and gave Him as head over all things to the church, 23 which is His body, the fulness of Him who fills all in all.
